Streamlined students from Low-risk countries (Offshore)

1. Our English and academic entry requirements for selected program must be met by the applicant.
2. Applicants need to complete along with their [International Student Application](#) to meet our requirements for offer assessment.
3. The applicant will be asked for supporting documents and [Simplified Student Visa Framework \(SSVF\) Genuine Temporary Entrant \(GTE\) questionnaire](#)
4. The applicant will be asked for supporting documents and / or a GTE interview for further Pre Visa-Assessment (PVA), if we have any concerns about the student's financial capacity or GTE.
5. Visa refusal risk factors may vary, due to different economic systems for each country and each individual, so the requirements for supporting documents for SSVF may also differ on a country by country, and case by case basis. In case we believe that due to a specific risk factor the Department of Home Affairs (DOHA) may reject the student's visa application, Mars Institute reserves the right to seek additional documentations / evidence and / or GTE interview.

Regular students from High-risk countries (Offshore)

1. Our English and academic entry requirements for selected program must be met by the applicant.
2. Applicants need to complete [Simplified Student Visa Framework \(SSVF\) Genuine Temporary Entrant \(GTE\) questionnaire](#) along with their [International Student Application](#) to meet our requirements for offer assessment, provide all supporting documents to prove that the funds are genuinely available to meet the financial requirements.
3. The applicant will be asked for supporting documents and / or a GTE interview for further Pre Visa-Assessment (PVA), if we have any concerns about the student's financial capacity or GTE.
4. Visa refusal risk factors may vary, due to different economic systems for each country and each individual, so the requirements for supporting documents for SSVF may also differ on a country by country, and case by case basis. In case we believe that due to a specific risk factor the Department of Home Affairs (DOHA) may reject the student's visa application, Mars Institute reserves the right to seek additional documentations / evidence and / or GTE interview.

3. The applicant may be asked for supporting documents and [Simplified Student Visa Framework \(SSVF\) Genuine Temporary Entrant \(GTE\) questionnaire](#)
4. The applicant may be asked for supporting documents and / or a GTE interview for further Pre Visa-Assessment (PVA), If we have any concerns about the student's financial capacity or GTE.
5. 
Document Checklist Tool
